



## NATIONAL TELE-SUPPORT NETWORK FOR PARENTS OF CHILDREN WITH VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

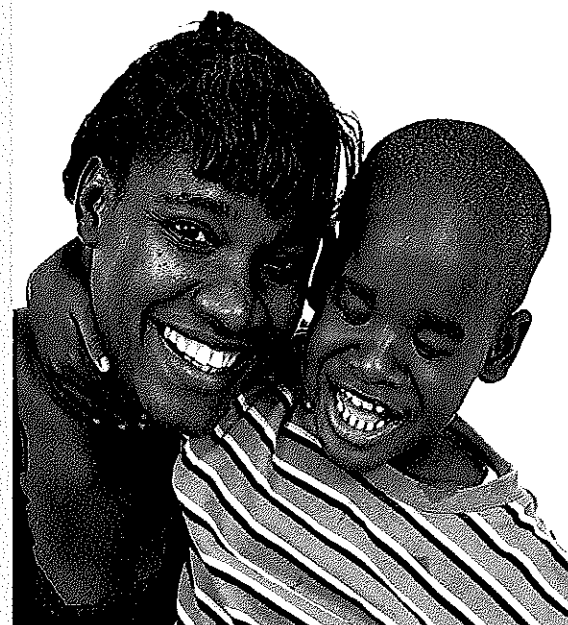
When your child is diagnosed with a serious eye condition that can cause blindness or vision impairment, you may feel lost and alone, and unsure of what your child needs.

Our free **National Tele-Support Network for Parents of Children with Visual Impairment** connects you with parents whose children have the same impairment so you share resources, experiences, strength and hope.

Tele-support groups meet by phone every week, and are facilitated by a Psychologist or Social Worker with input from professionals knowledgeable about children's eye conditions.

Our free **Teen Tele-support Group** is for high school seniors who are visually impaired or blind and are planning to attend college. The group meets by phone to share experiences and ask questions of current college students and recent graduates who are also blind or visually impaired.
