July 8th-12th, 2019: Elementary Week (students entering 1st grade-5th grade)

July 22nd – 26th, 2019: Middle/High Week (students entering 6th grade – 10th grade)

Because it's never too soon to teach students skills they need to be prepared for life, MSB's **TRECCK for Success** is a **FREE** one-week program that provides instruction in the Expanded Core Curriculum (**ECC**) through fun themed classes and activities. Taught by staff experienced in working with visually impaired students, **ECC** skills that will specifically be addressed include: compensatory skills (organizational skills and adaptations for accessing curriculum), O&M, social skills, use of assistive technology and sensory efficiency skills (use of residual vision, hearing and other senses; use of optical devices). Field trips related to the theme will be included. Students will have the opportunity to develop friendships with visually impaired peers from across the state and connect with blind role models. From new technology to adapted sports, students will learn how to use accommodations to participate in instructional and recreational activities they may not otherwise be able to experience.
