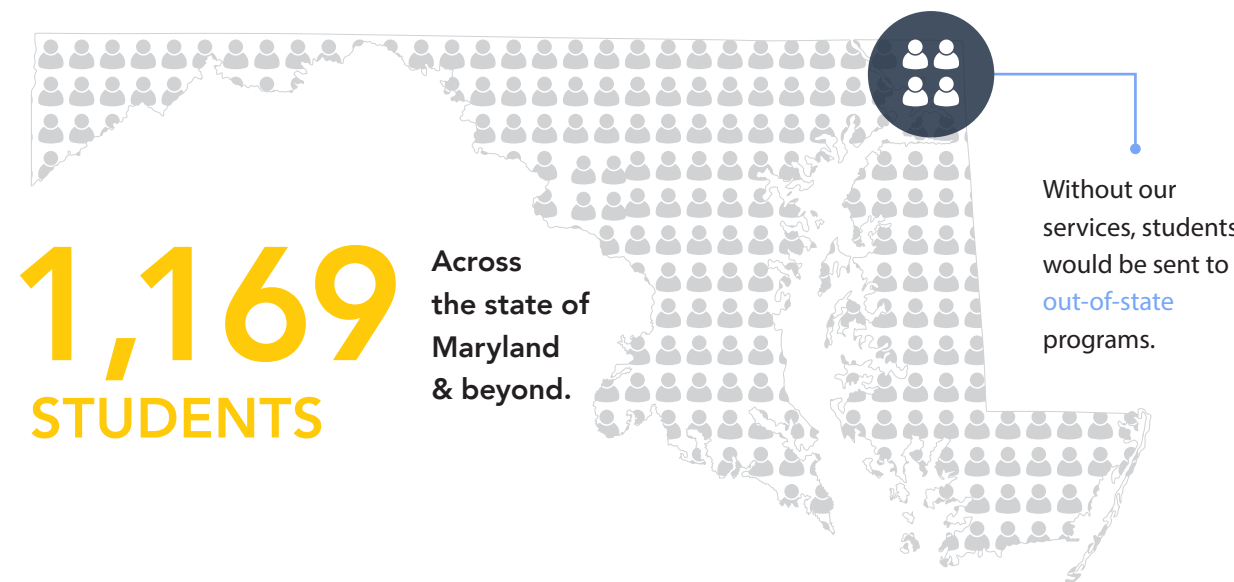

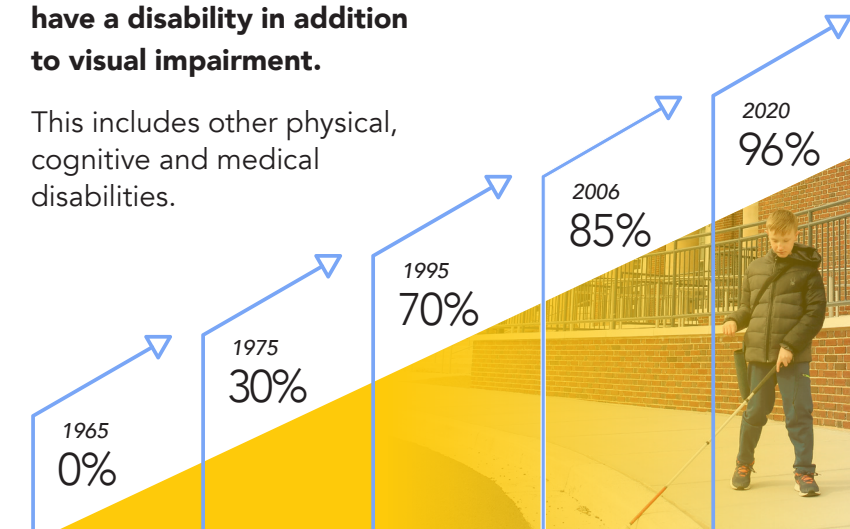

## Community Outreach Programs

### *The Maryland Instructional Resource Center (MIRC)*

A centralized repository for braille and large print textbooks, including a centralized searching, ordering, procurement and shipping facility for the textbooks

### *Infant & Toddler (I&T) Services*

Part of a statewide early intervention program provided to children from birth to four years old who have suspected or diagnosed visual impairments

### *Preschool-21 Year Old Services*

Provided to students statewide who do not attend MSB's campus based educational programs include: Low-Vision Service, On-site Services, Trainings, Student Social Activities, Short Courses and Summer Programs
