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Dear Parents/Guardians:

We look forward to having your child back at The Maryland School for the Blind for the 2022-2023 School Year. To help us prepare for their safe return we need your help.

Make sure to make an appointment with your child's Primary Care Provider/Physician. Please complete attached forms, return them to the Health Center by **July 14, 2022** and deliver medications to school by **August 22, 2022**, so that reconciliation can be done in an unrushed and careful way.

Registration Forms (Use as a checklist)

Signed by the Parent/Guardian and required for ALL students

Signed by the Doctor and required for ALL students
<input type="checkbox"/> Physical Activity Form- also needs signed by the parent/guardian
<input type="checkbox"/> Physician's Nutrition Order Form for students with nutritional concerns – GT Feeding

If applicable for your student:

- Gastrostomy Feeding Orders- Required for students who have a G-tube and filled out/signed by the doctor
 - GT students must have a complete unexpired replacement kit at school before the start of school.
- Medication Administration Authorization Form- Required for students who receive medications while at school and filled out/signed by the doctor and signed by the parent
- Part 1 – Sports/Physical History by Parent- Filled out/signed by the parent
- Part 2 – Sports/Physical History by Physician- Required for all students over 13 years of age, who will be participating in any MSB sports and filled out/signed by the doctor.**
- Immunization Form - If included in your packet, necessary immunization documentation updates are required

Medications

Before the medications can be administered in the school setting in accordance to Maryland State regulations:

- Medication orders and medication labels on the prescription bottle **must match**
- Over-the-counter medications (vitamins, creams, and ointments) must be in a pharmacy labeled container or have a pharmacy label attached to the box or tube. Label must match medication order that accompanies medication.**

Please remember that the registration paper is important to the care of your child. Failure to send in completed paperwork can result in a delayed start of school for your child.
